Role: Swim Wales Learn to Swim Working Group Representative (Volunteer)

Role Purpose: To support the nation to become aquatically active through supporting the strategic development of and being a voice for Learn to Swim in Wales.

To support the development of Learn to Swim in Wales and to provide consultation input within this area of the Aquatic Pathway to realise Swim Wales' strategic aims.

You will be responsible for supporting the development of Learn to Swim within Wales.

Swim Wales has a strong commitment to improving equality and diversity within aquatic provision. It is expected that the post-holder will uphold this commitment and demonstrate the appropriate inclusive behaviours to support achievement of these aims.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Support the Swim Wales National Learn to Swim Manager, Aquatic Development Team and/or Business Development Team in developing new and revising existing Learn to Swim products and resources;
- 2. Identifying appropriate training requirements and content for Learn to Swim providers and teachers;
- 3. Work in partnership with Swim Wales staff and stakeholders to develop a greater understanding of the Learn to Swim landscape in Wales
- 4. Ensure all work relating to the Swim Wales Learn to Swim Consultation Group is reflective of, and aligned to the Swim Wales Strategy: YMLAEN.
- 5. Support the planning of the Swim Wales Learn to Swim Upskilling Series.
- 6. As part of the wider group, support the shortlisting of nominations for Learn to Swim related categories of the Swim Wales Awards.
- 7. Improve equality and diversity within learn to swim, whilst upholding Swim Wales vision of *Aquatics for Everyone for Life*
- 8. Adhere to and uphold all Swim Wales policies and procedures including the Swim Wales Code of Ethics and Swim Wales Code of Conduct
